**Course Title: Open Air Landscape Painting**

**Course Code:FA18001OE**

**Course Duration:** 40 Hours.

- Understanding the elements of landscape composition
- Techniques for depicting perspective, distance, and atmospheric effects in landscapes

## Mixed Media Techniques

- Exploring mixed media approaches in Landscape painting, combining various materials such as collage, and unconventional tools.
- Techniques for layering and building texture in mixed media artworks.
- General knowledge about local and contemporary artist of J&K

## Contemporary Painting Styles

- Survey of contemporary painting styles and movements
- Analysis of works by contemporary artists and their techniques

## Final Projects

- Students will work on individual painting projects, applying the techniques and concepts learned throughout the course
- Guidance and feedback sessions to refine and complete final works.

## Exhibition Preparation

- Preparation for an end-of-semester exhibition showcasing students' artwork
- Selection, framing, and presentation of final pieces

## Resources:

- Painting materials: acrylic paints, oil paints, watercolour paints, brushes, palettes, canvases, paper
- Reference books and articles on painting techniques, art history, and contemporary art
- Online resources, tutorials, and videos for supplemental learning.
